### **APA: how to cite a book [Update 2020] - BibGuru Guides**

If the book or chapter you are citing lists a DOI, include it at the end of your

reference in place of the publisher information, without a period. Cite the edition of the book you used. If there aren't multiple editions of the book, or if it isn't a multivolume work, then do not include this information in your reference.

American Psychological Association. (2010). *Publication manual of the American Psychological Association* (6th ed.). Washington, D.C.: Author. Explanation: This includes a name of a study group, government agency, association, corporation, etc. Put the name of the group author in the author position followed by a period.

### **Apa Sixth Edition Book Reference**

To cite a book in a reference entry in APA style 6th edition include the following elements: Author(s) of the book: Give the last name and initials (e. g. Watson, J. D.) of up to seven authors with the last name preceded by an ampersand (&). For eight or more authors include the first six names followed by an ellipsis (...) and add the last author's name.

This is not necessary for a first edition.

Numbers in parentheses refer to specific pages in the APA 6th Edition manual. APA Citation Style does not have a separate category for government publications. According to APA, government documents can be considered Books, Technical/Research Reports or Brochures.

### **A guide to APA referencing - 6th edition**

Provide the author, year of publication, title, and publisher of the book. Include any edition information in parentheses after the title, without italics. If the book includes a DOI, include the DOI in the reference after the publisher name. Do not include the publisher location.

Basic book citation format The APA in-text citation for a book includes the author's last name, the year, and (if relevant) a page number. In the reference list, start with the author's last name and initials, followed by the year. The book title is written in sentence case (only capitalize the first word and any proper nouns).
