Some were used in attack groups as a temporary replacement for the unsatisfactory Breda Ba.65.

The three-engined Caproni Ca.3 was a massive aircraft for its day, with a 36 foot fuselage and 74 foot wing span, and could carry an 800kg bomb load several hundred miles. The type evolved from the

Ca.1 of 1914 and Ca.2 of 1915, but differed mainly in having more powerful engines.

These systems could transport up to six passengers in relative comfort and fell under the Caproni designation of "Ca.56". The Improved Ca.2 and the Definitive Ca.3 The Caproni Ca.2 ("Caproni 350hp") was a minor variation (improved engines) on the strengths of the Ca.1 platform. Development ultimately led to the definitive Ca.3 bomber platform.
