CRIMINAL LAW AMENDMENT ACT 105 OF 1997

2.— (1) In this Act, and in any amendment made by this Act in any other enactment— “ arrestable offence” means an offence for which a person of full capacity and not previously convicted may, F1 [under or by virtue of any enactment or the common law], be punished by imprisonment for a term of five years or by a more severe penalty and includes an attempt to commit any such offence;

The Criminal Law Act 1997 defines an arrestable offence as an offence that you could be punished by imprisonment for 5 years or more, similar to the definition of a serious offence mentioned above. This distinction holds great importance for the Gardaí.

Powers of dealing with offenders. 10. — (1) Where a person is convicted on indictment of an offence against any enactment and is for that offence liable to be sentenced to imprisonment but the sentence is not by any enactment either limited to a specified term or expressed to extend to imprisonment for life, the person so convicted shall be liable to imprisonment for not more than two years.

An assault is the act of inflicting physical harm or unwanted physical contact upon a person or, in some specific legal definitions, a threat or attempt to commit such an action. It is both a crime and a tort and, therefore, may result in criminal prosecution, civil liability, or both. Generally, the common law definition is the same in criminal and tort law.
