If pivot tables created 'linked' using same data then refresh on one pivot table sufficient to enable all associated pivot tables to be updated. (good practice) Option to have refresh set when opening file although it appears simple solution it can and 'does' result in a delay in opening files, hence first option 'data refresh all ...

Click a cell in the source data or table range. Go to Insert > PivotTable. If you're using Excel for Mac 2011 and earlier, the PivotTable button is on the Data tab in the Analysis group. Excel will display the Create PivotTable dialog with your range or table name selected.
