Bartholomeu Dias was the first European to sail around the southern tip of Africa. He reached Mossel Bay in 1488 and on his way back to Portugal saw the Cape peninsular for the first time and named it the 'Cape of Storms' because of the bad weather the ships experienced there.

In 1657 the colonial authorities started a process of allotting farms to European settlers (" free burghers ") in the arable regions around Cape Town, where wine and wheat became the major products. As the port developed the need for labour increased.
