The Pallava era witnesses a transition from rock-cut to free-standing temples. Mahendravarman was a pioneer in rock-cut architecture. Mandagapattu rock-cut temple was the first rock-cut temple built by him. Narasimhavarman II also known as Rajasimha built the Kanchi Kailasanatha Temple during the late 7th century AD.
